Suspension Procedures

The final authority for suspension of a student receiving services from the Joint Agreement lies with the Board of Education of the student's district of residence. The policy provided within the district of residence for suspension of students will be followed, including the due process procedures, in compliance with the provisions of IDEA and Section 504, if applicable

For SELA Students

In-School Suspension

The Director or designee is authorized to maintain an in-school suspension program. The program shall include, at a minimum, each of the following:

1. Before assigning a student to in-school suspension, the charges will be explained and the student will be given an opportunity to respond to the charges.
2. Students are supervised by licensed school personnel.
3. Students are given the opportunity to complete classroom work during the in-school suspension for equivalent academic credit.
